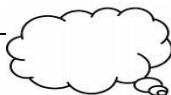

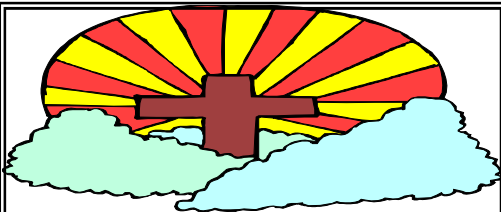

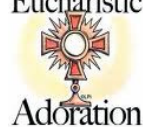
Bus will leave Parish Church at
