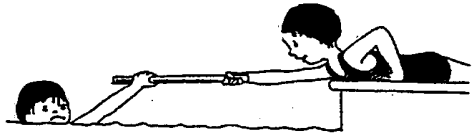

**Bus will leave Parish Church at 5am on Saturday 3rd September.**

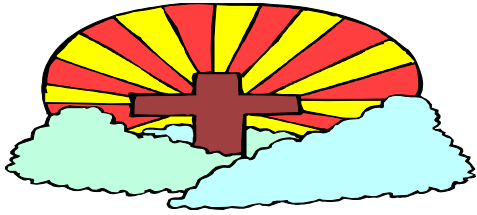

## **New Steps**

### **"Revival Skill Training and Support Programme for Women "**

Forward Steps Resource Centre Ltd. is launching it's third **FREE** part-time FETAC Level 3 accredited Revival Skill Training and Support Programme, specifically aimed at women in the County Carlow area who are currently unemployed, or, working in the home, or, on the live register, or from low-income families who would like to enhance their skills, qualifications and employment opportunities. A key element of the programmes is one to one mentoring to help participants achieve their individual work-life ambitions. The programme will also consist of 3 of the following FETAC **Level 3 courses:**Communication Skills (Improve conversation, write effective letters, improve your keyboard skills, introduction to e-mail.)

**Preparation for Work skills** (Career guidance will be introduced to support each person to focus on the future)

**Basic Computer Skills** (Word processing, spreadsheets, Internet) To facilitate participants, training will be rolled out in Tullow over three half days 9.45am -12.45pm (Wed, Thurs and Friday morning) commencing

**Wednesday September 28th for ten weeks.** As places are limited on the programme **early registration is advised.**
