**KILLOUGHTERNANE DRAMA GROUP 2010**

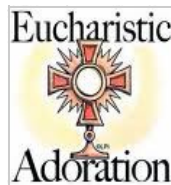

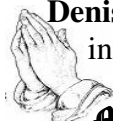
