3. In order to celebrate this day, it is recommended to pray the Chaplet and the Novena of the Divine Mercy, go to confession (after a deep examination of conscience), and to receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast of Divine Mercy.

4. The main purpose of the Feast of Divine Mercy is to sent the entire world an important message; God is merciful and He loves us all.
