Once again, the diocese will be present in Ratheniska for the Ploughing Championships this year. At our Diocesan Stand 221 visitors will be invited to pledge their desire for peace in our world by placing a coloured pin on a specially designed St. Brigid's Cross, which, we hope, will be presented to Pope Francis next year during World Youth Day in Rome. The St Brigid's Cloak created on the Stand last year will be on display, a vivid reminder of the importance of our Diocesan Patron Saint and the 1500th anniversary that we are currently celebrating.

Bishop Denis especially looks forward to welcoming the many people from our parishes who will visit Ratheniska this week. The 'Pledge Your Pin For Peace' initiative will be a practical way of expressing our 'no' to the horrific wars that are affecting the lives of so many all over the globe. It is hoped that in pledging a pin for peace people will make a commitment to pray for peace. An initiative to set our phones to 'Ping for Peace' will also be launched.

Bishop Denis is delighted that the Bell of St. Columbanus will be rung for peace every hour on our Stand. This Bell was cast a decade ago to mark the 1400th anniversary of the missionary born in Myshall, Co. Carlow, who brought Celtic Christianity to parts of France and Italy. Bishop Denis will host the 26th International Columbanus Day in Carlow next July, the first time it is being held in the Republic of Ireland.

As always, the cherished tradition of having blessed salt available to bring home and spread on land and gardens will continue. The Church is continuing its drive to promote vocations to the priesthood and a section of the Kildare & Leighlin tent will be devoted to encouraging people to foster callings to priestly ministry.
